

2017 CATS STATISTICS


The Commercial Advancement Training Scheme has been taking on students since it's inception in 2005. There have been a total of 134 recorded CATS students to date including the students that are due to graduate on the 20th September 2017.




The following charts will look at the number of students that have been selected for the program between 2010-2017.

*A total of 23 students in 2010 found placement in various member companies to complete the CATS program as required.

The below graph details which companies took on students respectively.




In 2011 a total of 20 students were taken on by various member companies. The graphs illustrates the number of students each member company offered training to:




In 2012 a total of 17 students got training placement amongst the CATS member companies. The year 2011 & 2012 saw the beginning of the decline in the number of students sponsored from 23 in the year 2010 to 20 and 17 in the years 2011 and 2012 respectively.

The number of member companies had not changed by much at this point and so no correlation between the number of companies and the intake number could be determined at this point.



In 2013, 14 students got training placement. This was 3 students less than the previous year.




In 2014 a total of 17 students received training placement. This number saw


The increase of 3 more students placed in comparison to the year 2013.

The increase might have been due to the addition of another member company


To the program.




In 2015 a total of 14 students received training placement. CATS experienced the lowest number of active member companies at only 7 companies taking on students that year.




In 2016, 12 students received training placement within 9 member companies.



In 2017 a total of 17 students were awarded with training placement.




*Summary of number of students placed between 2010 and 2017

A comparison of the total number of applications received in the year 2016 vs. 2017. There were more applications received in 2016 compared to 2017 however there were Also less students taken on for the program.


CATS received 284 less applications in 2017 compared to 2016, however; 3 more students compared to the year 2016 were placed with a company.

*The evaluations were completed by the 18 students that attended the workshop.




CATS Graduate Stats


The following charts aim to illustrate the number of graduates per training company from the year 2014 to 2017. *Please note that the 2010 graduation stats were not available

In 2014 a total of 7 students graduated from the CATS program.


The below and following graphs illustrate the number of graduates that each member company has had the honour of seeing graduate..




In 2015 a total of 13 students graduated from various training companies. Transworld Cargo and PW Motors had the highest number of graduates that year.




In 2016 a total of 21 students graduated from the various training companies. Transworld Cargo had the highest number of graduates for that year.



In 2017 a total of 15 students are expected to graduate from various training companies.






CATS Tracer Studies

CATS Tracer Study Results: 2015




This chart provides detail about the positions in which the respondents are as well as the length of time they have been employed.

CATS Tracer Study 2017: Employment details






CATS 2017 Teambuilding

The focus on these statistics was to illustrate the interest for a teambuilding function by the CATS students. The value that the students hold for team building functions is understood and illustrated through these stats.




86% of the students are excited about teambuilding functions.

There were a total of 25 students at the 2017 teambuilding function of which only 22 completed the questionnaire. 22 students will attend another function in future and confirmed that they learned something new at the function.



There is a 87% satisfaction rate with the overall event and 78% of the students felt that the teambuilding met the objective of creating a team spirit. The least appreciated aspect of the teambuilding was the design of the activities with 57% of the students rating it as simply good and not very good.



57% of the students that attended the teambuilding were female. The 2017 tracer study has also illustrated that 59% of the CATS graduates have been female including the 2017 graduates.
